

TEAM COMPETITION 101

How would you like to carry home a throwing hawk, axe, knife or compass?

Most items are hand forged, hand-made with quality that'll last you a lifetime.

How Team Competition works:

- **The fund raising challenge**
 - Individuals that wish to raise money for the trip, by doing yard work, asking for sponsorship or other, end up winners, able to choose from an assortment of items for raising funds towards the cause.

Raising funds is up to you. Mowing lawns, extra chores or perhaps turning in cans, what you raise, dictates what you will have a chance to earn - choosing from off the trade blanket.

Trade Blankets were used by voyageurs to display trade items. In similar fashion, we use the trade blanket to award successful Voyagers.

Below are examples of the items each attendee has a chance to earn. There ARE minimums based on what may be selected. This will be explained on all trips when selecting items from the Trade Blanket. Trade items are in three categories:



- Team Competition
 - During Voyager events, competitions are held in a variety of ways. Awards are provided to those who strive to achieve excellence in the competitions.



The Voyagers have a saying - 'Loyalty, above all else loyalty'. This statement is captured on our Voyager Leather badge which may be used on your toque, pack as shown above.

In addition the badges include the phrase "Per Ardua" which means through difficulties. Attendees will earn this badge through attendance of Voyager trips.

Interested in earning a "Toque"? Raise \$75.00 or more - or - the Toque may be purchased for \$45.00 plus S/H. The Toques are made of 100% Wool and are historically accurate to those worn by the Voyagers during the 18th & 19th centuries.

Each hat is made locally by Jan Boerema and may be made to size.
